Background: May regulate the transport and translation of mRNAs of proteins involved in synaptic plasticity in neurons and cell proliferation and migration in multiple cell types. Binds directly and selectively to MYC and CCND2 RNAs. In neuronal cells, directly binds to several mRNAs associated with RNA granules, including BDNF, CAMK2A, CREBI, MAP2, NTRK2 mRNAs, as well as to GRINI and KPNBI mRNAs, but not to rRNAs. Immunogen: Fusion protein of human CAPRINI

In comparision with the IHC on the left, the same paraffin-embedded Human cervical cancer tissue is first treated with the fusion protein and then with 210917(Anti-CAPRIN1 Antibody) at dilution 1/50.



In comparision with the IHC on the left, the same paraffin-embedded Human esophagus cancer tissue is first treated with fusion protein and then with D121882(Anti-CAPRINI Antibody) at dilution 1/50.
