






In comparision with the IHC on the left, the same paraffin-embedded Human liver cancer tissue is first treated with the fusion protein and then with 218640(Anti-DIMT1 Antibody) at dilution 1/30.



The image on the left is immunohistochemistry of paraffin-embedded Human esophagus cancer tissue using 218640 (Anti-DIMT1 Antibody) at a dilution of 1/30.



In comparision with the IHC on the left, the same paraffin-embedded Human esophagus cancer tissue is first treated with fusion protein and then with D224853(Anti-DIMTI Antibody) at dilution 1/30.
