Background: The protein encoded by this gene is a cellular protein that binds RNAs containing the G-rich element. The protein is localized in the cytoplasm, and has been shown to stimulate translation of viral mRNAs in vitro. Multiple transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been found for this gene.

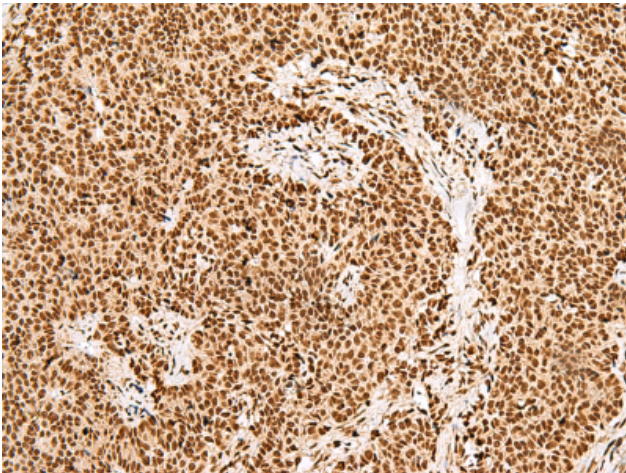

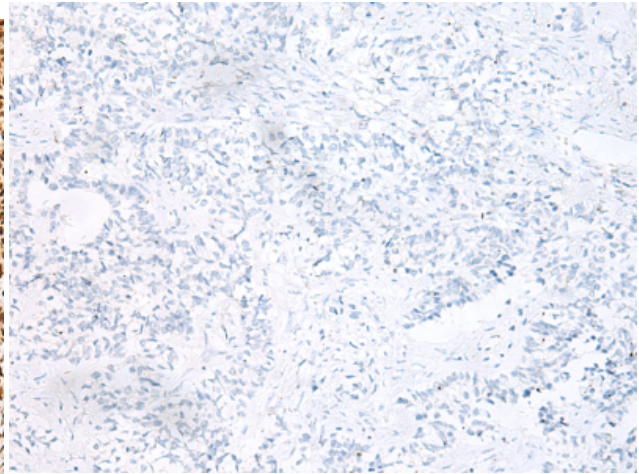

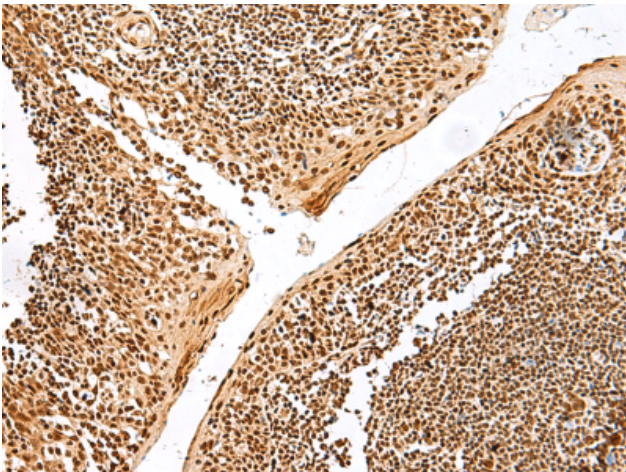
Storage & Shipping: Store at -20°C. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing



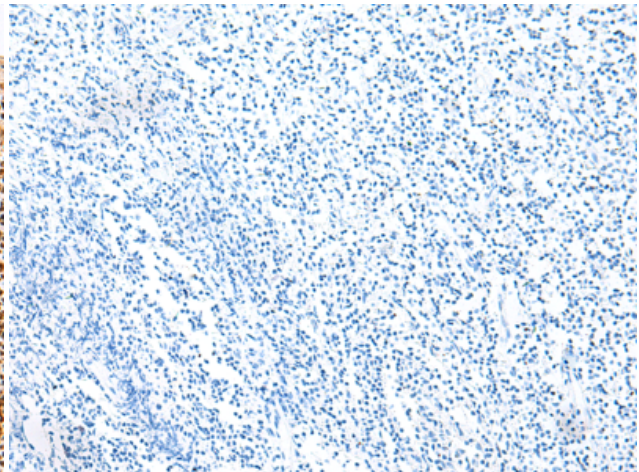

In comparison with the IHC on the left, the same paraffin-embedded Human ovarian cancer tissue is first treated with the synthetic peptide and then with 215924 (Anti-GRSF1 Antibody) at dilution 1/30.



The image on the left is immunohistochemistry of paraffin-embedded Human tonsil tissue using 215924 (Anti-GRSF1 Antibody) at a dilution of 1/30.



In comparison with the IHC on the left, the same paraffin-embedded Human tonsil tissue is first treated with synthetic peptide and then with D164133 (Anti-GRSF1 Antibody) at dilution 1/30.
