Background: The piggyBac family of proteins, found in diverse animals, are transposases related to the transposase of the canonical piggyBac transposon from the moth, Trichoplusia ni. This family also includes genes in several genomes, including human, that appear to have been derived from the piggyBac transposons. This gene belongs to the subfamily of piggyBac transposable element derived (PGBD) genes. The PGBD proteins appear to be novel, with no obvious relationship to other transposases, or other known protein families.









In comparision with the IHC on the left, the same paraffin-embedded Human brain tissue is first treated with the synthetic peptide and then with 220025 (Anti-PGBD5 Antibody) at dilution 1/20.



The image on the left is immunohistochemistry of paraffinembedded Human thyroid cancer tissue using 220025(Anti-PGBD5 Antibody) at a dilution of 1/20.



In comparision with the IHC on the left, the same paraffin-embedded Human thyroid cancer tissue is first treated with synthetic peptide and then with D260797(Anti-PGBD5 Antibody) at dilution 1/20.
