Background: This gene encodes a member of the RING-B-box-coiled-coil (RBCC) family and encodes a protein with an N-terminal RING finger motif, a PRY domain and a C-terminal SPRY domain. The mouse ortholog of this gene is specifically expressed in germ cells at the round spermatid stages during spermatogenesis and, when overexpressed, induces apoptosis. Alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding distinct isoforms have been described.







Immunohistochemistry analysis of paraffin embedded Human esophagus cancer tissue using 217777(TRIM69 Antibody) at a dilution of 1/40(Cytoplasm or Nucleus).



In comparision with the IHC on the left, the same paraffin-embedded Human esophagus cancer tissue is first treated with the fusion protein and then with 217777(Anti-TRIM69 Antibody) at dilution 1/40.
