This cytokine is a ligand for receptors TNFRSF13B:TACI; TNFRSF17:BCMA; and TNFRSF13C:BAFFR. This cytokine is expressed in B cell lineage cells; and acts as a potent B cell activator. It has been also shown to play an important role in the proliferation and differentiation of B cells. Alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding distinct isoforms have been identified.**Applications:** ELISA; Flow Cyt**Recommended Dilutions:** ELISA 1:5000-10000; Flow Cyt 1:100**Host Species:** Rabbit**Isotype:** Rabbit IgG**Purification:** Purified from cell culture supernatant by affinity chromatography**Species Reactivity:** Human BAFF**Constituents:** Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4. 5 % – 8% trehalose is added as protectants before lyophilization.**Storage & Shipping:** Store at -20°C to -80°C for 12 months in lyophilized form. After reconstitution, if not intended for use within a month, aliquot and store at -80°C (Avoid repeated freezing and thawing).

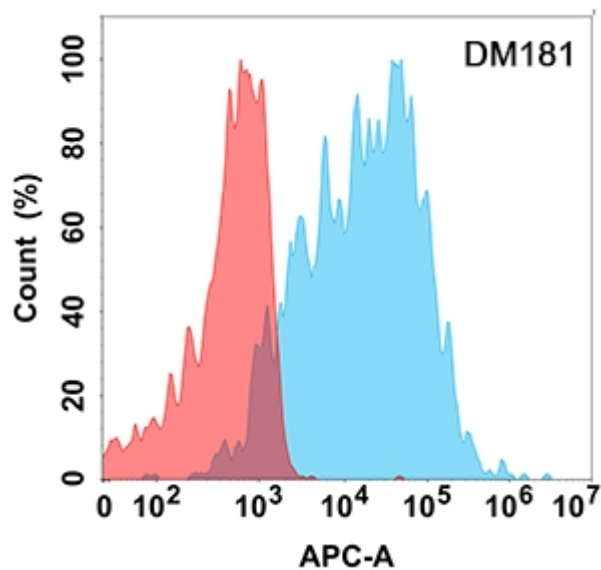


Figure 1. Flow cytometry analysis with Anti-BAFF (DM181) on Expi293 cells transfected with human BAFF (Blue histogram) or Expi293 transfected with irrelevant protein (Red histogram).
